Why This Matters Right Now

Colorado finance teams operate in environments where fund classification, enterprise transparency, and documentation clarity matter year-round. First Quarter of the Year identification efforts help agencies understand what may exist before audit preparation and refund-related analysis begin. This process also gives insight into valuable internal control practices and policies.

This is a visibility exercise — not a commitment to recovery.

What Finance Directors Are Seeing

- Potential unclaimed property tied to utilities and enterprise operations
- Legacy balances associated with annexation or service-area changes
- Prior searches limited to a single entity name
- Claims requiring clearer documentation paths before pursuit
