Why This Matters Right Now

Rapid growth, annexation, and system changes make Texas cities especially prone to accumulating unclaimed property over time. First Quarter of the Year identification helps agencies understand potential exposure early in the fiscal year. This process also gives insight into valuable internal control practices and policies.
